RE: Home Team Advantage Inc. John Ostendorf, Douglas  
Livingston, Hillary Livingston and Indecor

Dear Mr. Falconetti:

The undersigned attorney represents Home Team Advantage Inc. John Ostendorf, Douglas Livingston, Hillary Livingston and has been asked to respond by Indecor in the above referenced matter. On November 2, 2007 we submitted a letter to you demanding:

a. return the original and all copies of the customer list of Home Team that you obtained and has used without the consent or knowledge of Home Team. Such customer list is a confidential document which you knowingly has used to further your own interest and which conduct violates Florida Statute 688.

b. immediately cease and desist from contacting any customer of Home Team.

c. immediately cease and desist from contacting the State of Florida, State Attorney Office, DBPR, Better Business Bureau with respect to any customer of Home Team.

d. immediately cease and desist using privacy information of Home Team customers.

e. immediately cease and desist from using the name Home Team Disadvantage which is confusing to the public and trading and using the corporate name of Home Team Advantage.

f. immediately cease and desist in using search engines incorporating the name Home Team Advantage and thereby seeking to benefit from the use of the name Home Team Advantage.

g. remove your story as to the false allegations concerning the permit status, permit approvals, allegations of theft, contract terms. Such intended public dissemination is deemed to be libel per se.

h. remove the facts concerning our clients which is a misrepresentation of the facts.

i. remove permanently your web site as connected with Home Team Advantage Inc.

You did not respond to our letter or acquiesce to our requests. Instead you have continued to defame are clients.

You have now sought to link Indecor a separate and independent company which is not controlled by the owners of Home Team Advantage nor which is a company which is operating as a general contractor. Your statement to the public indicates that Indecor is a new company of our clients such that it is name change only- which statement is false and reckless by you.

Florida law does not permit a person to make false statements of fact which are known to be false to disparage another. Indecor, Home Team Advantage, Doug Livingston, Hillary Livingston and John Ostendorf will jointly and severally seek to take all legal action against you if you fail to cease and desist your reckless and false statements.

We note that your job is completed, but you have deliberately failed to identify the true facts of your project so as to deceive the public. If you have a specific written list of what you claim to be problems with your completed job, please furnish a list directly to the undersigned and I will review same with Home Team Advantage to seek to rectify any problem that truly exists. However you must cease your relentless attack upon our clients and worse your improper statement to tie Indecor with Home Team Advantage Inc.


If you fail to cease and desist on each and every demand, our clients are prepared to file suit in Broward County Florida for injunctive relief, damages for civil wrongs and tortious interference with contracts, and as appropriate attorney fees and costs against you. The filing of the lawsuit will be a matter of public record against you.

This is an attempt to collect a debt and any information obtained will be used for that purpose.

The debt described herein will be assumed to be valid by the creditor's law firm, unless the debtor, within thirty (30) days after the receipt of this Notice, disputes, in writing, the validity of the debt or some portion thereof. If the debtor notified the creditor's law firm in writing within twenty (20) days of the receipt of this notice that the debt or any portion thereof is disputed, the creditor's law firm will obtain a verification of the debt and a copy of the verification will be mailed to the debtor by the creditor's law firm.

**PLEASE BE GOVERNED ACCORDINGLY.**
